George Hagi

George Hagi was born on 5th February in Săcel, Constanța. He is considered one of the best attacking midfielders in Europe during the 1980s and 1990s. He is also considered the greatest Romanian footballer of all time. He is now a coach at Viitorul. In Romania he is known as the king of the football.

George Hagi started playing football at ten years old at Forul Constanța. In his career he evolved at Forul Studentesc, Steaua București. Hagi and Steaua won Cupa României in 1987-1988-1989. At national team he managed 125 matches and he scored 35 goals. He was signed by Real Madrid and he played two seasons there, and after he was sold to Barcelona.

Hagi managed to overcome many opponents during the game. Although he didn't excel in speed, he easily oriented, which allowed him to shoot successfully from a distance.

Galatasaray fans called him The Commander.
