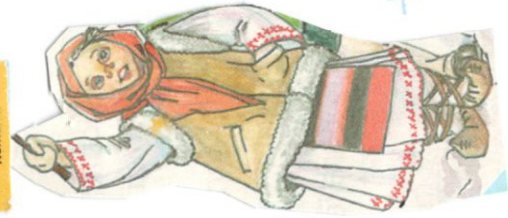


Romanian's National Day
